The Club, one of the oldest in Ohio, has about 350 members and features a 900-acre property with 87 estate residences; a Donald Ross designed golf course; 300 acre private lake for boating, sailing, and fishing; a resort style swimming pool, racquet sports including 6 Har-tru courts, 2 platform courts, and tennis clubhouse; and a 50,000 square foot clubhouse with indoor and outdoor dining, banquet facilities, 10 overnight guest rooms, 2 kitchens, and other F & B outlets. \$6M in annual revenue including over \$2M annual F & B sales (extensive in season ala carte activity).

- Reporting of operational metrics for departments under his/her authority including all kitchen financial reports
- Internal cost control of beverages, food, labor, and supplies
- Purchasing of liquor, beer, wine, beverages, linen and supplies
- Maintaining a high-quality wine program
- Promotion of dining and beverage operations including events, wine sales, entertainment, and sales
- Overseeing the Youth and Social Director and the Club's childrens' activities
